Mandate

Table Tennis Wales Selection panel was established to act as the committee to make the selections for Table Tennis Wales to represent Wales at major competitions which include but not limited to

- a. World Individual Championships
- b. World Team Championships
- c. European Individual Championships
- d. European Team Championships including qualifying rounds
- e. Commonwealth Games
- f. Commonwealth Championships
- g. European Youth Championships
- h. Home Nations
- i. Senior Schools
- j. Primary Schools
- k. Euro Minis

The panel will also be responsible for the approval of applications from the National squad to play at international events under the Table Tennis Wales, Such as WTT events and International opens

Selection Panel

The selection panel is made up of the following people:

- Joshua Morgan – TTW National Coach
- Matthew Porter – TTW Swansea Development Officer
- Catherine Jones – Independent player representative
- Neil Robinson – British Para Table Tennis Coach

Meetings

The Panel will meet minimum of 4 times a year (every Quarter), depending on the yearly major events calendar there is no minimum number of the times the committee will meet.

Voting Process

The selection panel will meet and discuss all selections, and should a player selection not be agreed, each panel member will have an equal voting right (1 vote per panel member leading to a majority vote). The ballots of any votes required shall remain confidential.

Proxy voting

In the event of a panel meeting requiring a vote and a panel member being absent, the National Coach will get their vote via proxy.

Selection Timelines

All selections made for major competitions (outlined in the major competitions selection policy) must be announced on the TTW website no later than 28 days prior to the event.
