The South Wales Summer Junior League will run for 5 consecutive weeks.

Code of Conduct

By entering the 'South Wales Summer Junior League' each player commits to the code of conduct which is a requirement of all players holding a valid membership, these codes can be found on Table Tennis Wales Website, and when completing your Table Tennis Wales Player Membership.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Name**
The Competition shall be called "South Wales Summer Junior League". The title may also include the name of a sponsor or product.
- 2. Competition**
Entry is open to:
a) All Clubs affiliated to the Table Tennis Association of Wales Limited.
- 3. Management**
The South Wales Junior League shall be organised by the Competitions Committee.
- 4. Divisions**
Divisions will generally unless otherwise notified consist of 6 teams. Entry will be restricted, and will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.
- 5. Players - Eligibility to play**
Subject to the provisions below players may play in the 'South Wales Summer Junior League' for any team.
a) All players must hold a **valid Competitive Membership** to Table Tennis Wales, or hold an equivalent to another ITTF Affiliated Association, **for the whole of the 2023-2024. No player shall compete without a valid Competitive Membership.**
b) Players shall be bound to the club & team they have been registered by after the first match played subject to the transfer process below.
c) A player may play for a higher team of the same club. On a third appearance for a higher team the player is then bound to the higher team for the remainder of the season. In the event of a



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player playing for more than one higher team of the same league he/she is then bound to a higher team. In such a case the Organiser will decide which higher team it shall be.

d) No player shall play for 2 teams in the division in which they are registered.

e) If a player is playing up for a higher team, they will not be able to play for the lower team for that round of matches. i.e., No player will be allowed to play 2 matches at the same time.

6. Fixtures

Matches will be played at the venue set out in the entry and organiser by the competitions committee. TTW will use the TT Leagues Platform for all fixtures.

7. Team Matches - Number of Events

Each team match shall consist of 4 individual matches and 1 doubles match. Each player playing two members of the opposing team, the best of five games of 11 points. The result of each team match shall be determined by the individual match results. League points shall be awarded as in Rule 8. All matches shall be played to a finish. All matches will be played using an approved ball supplied by TTW.

8. Method of Awarding League Points

In each team match overall league points shall be awarded as follows:

2 points to the winning team

1 point to the losing team

9. Constitution of Teams and Divisions

a) Teams shall consist of a minimum of two players.

b) All divisions shall be shaped and determined by the competitions committee, considering player ranking from the latest issue of the Welsh Rankings.

c) Individual teams can choose their team ranking order for each match which cannot be altered after the start of the match concerned. The two players selected to compete in the team match shall be allocated HOME - AB and Away – XY. Each team shall submit player order before the start of the game.

10. Order of play

The order of play may only be altered in exceptional

11. Safeguarding
