# A Historic Moment for Welsh Table Tennis

The Welsh Women's Team has qualified for the **World Championships** – a landmark achievement that marks a defining moment for the sport in Wales. This milestone is more than a competitive result; it is a powerful platform to inspire the next generation.

Table Tennis Wales believes that national success should create ripples throughout every community in the country. The Women & Girls Legacy Fund exists to turn that inspiration into tangible action – giving clubs, organisations, and communities the resources they need to welcome, retain, and celebrate women and girls in the sport.



# About the Legacy Fund

## What Is It?

A dedicated fund of **£10,000** launched by Table Tennis Wales to create a lasting legacy from the national team's World Championships qualification – directly benefiting women, girls, families, and the wider community.

## How Does It Work?

Clubs and organisations can apply for funding to support projects that improve their table tennis environment or participation opportunities. Funding is paid in **one instalment** following approval of the application and receipt of a signed Service Level Agreement.

Applications will be assessed against clear priority outcomes, with a focus on inclusion, sustainability, and community impact.

# Priority Outcomes

Projects will be prioritised where they demonstrate a clear contribution to one or more of the following outcomes:

1

## Increase Participation

Grow the number of women and girls actively participating in table tennis across Wales.

2

## Welcoming Environments

Create inclusive, supportive spaces within clubs where everyone feels they belong.

3

## School & Community Links

Develop meaningful pathways connecting schools, clubs, and community organisations.

4

## Partnerships

Support collaborative projects with charities and community groups to broaden reach.

5

## Club Sustainability

Strengthen clubs through improved facilities, equipment, or volunteer development.

6

## Welsh Language & Inclusivity

Promote the Welsh language and celebrate diversity within the table tennis community.

# Eligible Projects: Equipment

Investing in the right equipment is one of the most direct ways to open doors for new participants. The following equipment purchases are eligible for funding:

## Tables, Barriers & Coaching Kit

Purchase of tables, table tennis barriers, and professional coaching equipment to upgrade your facility.

## Women & Girls' Session Packages

Equipment packages specifically designed to support the launch of new dedicated women and girls' sessions at your club.

## Inclusive Participation Equipment

Adapted or specialist equipment that supports players of all abilities, backgrounds, and needs to participate fully.



# Eligible Projects: Participation & Partnerships

## School Pathways

Develop structured links with local schools to create clear, supported pathways for girls to transition from school sport into club membership and regular participation.

## Community & Family Spaces

Create welcoming social spaces or community activities that encourage whole-family participation, making table tennis a shared experience beyond competitive play.

## Charity & Community Partnerships

Collaborative projects with charities, third-sector organisations, or community groups that use table tennis as a vehicle for social wellbeing and broader inclusion.

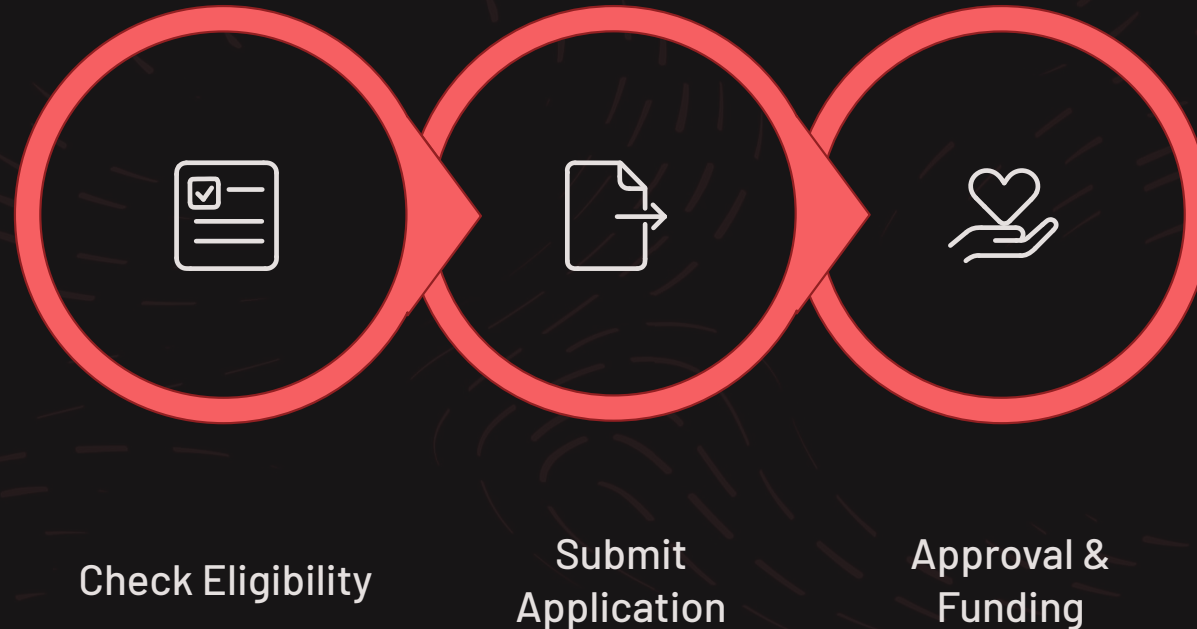
# Eligible Projects: Workforce Development

A thriving club needs great people. Funding is available for projects that help attract, develop, and retain the women and volunteers who make clubs run.

## Recruiting Under-Represented Groups

Innovative projects aimed at recruiting and retaining women, girls, and under-represented groups within your club's workforce — including mentoring schemes, taster events, or volunteer recognition programmes.

# How to Apply



The process is designed to be straightforward. Once your application is approved, you will be asked to sign a Service Level Agreement before funding is released in a single payment. We encourage clubs to get in touch with Table Tennis Wales if they have any questions before submitting.
