## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Completion and submission of the entry form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of this competition.
2. All competitors required to umpire.
3. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these regulations, and on any matters not covered by them.
4. Any item of clothing other than socks or shoes shall be in accordance with ITTF Clothing Regulation.
5. Racket covering materials shall follow ITTF Regulations regarding rubber coverings.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis except for the first rounds of the singles events, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. Seeded players and any other players on a national ranking list may be drawn into the competition proper.
7. All groups will qualify by date of birth as at 1st Jan of the year in question relating to the age category (Cadets 15, Juniors 19, Vets 40 etc)
8. The Committee reserves the right to decline or restrict entries and cancel events.
9. Players must report to the recorder's table on arrival and permission to leave the hall must be obtained from the Referee.
10. Signing of the entry form constitutes agreement by the Competitor, under the Data Protection Act 2018 and General Data Protection Regulation, to the storing of his or her name, and address, on a computer system for the sole use of this tournament.
